1.1. Minimum System Requirements

1.1.1. Windows

- ♦ Windows XP, 32 bit and 64 bit
- ♦ Windows Vista and Windows 7, 32 bit versions only.
- ♦ Hi-speed USB 2.0

IMPORTANT NOTE: LaCie USB Boost is not compatible with Macintosh and Linux operating systems and 64 bit versions of Windows Vista and Windows 7.

1.2. Administrator

In order to install the USB Boost driver, you must have Administrative rights to your computer.

2. Installing LaCie USB Boost

2.1. Installation

- Locate the USB Boost icon in your LaCie Utilities folder on your newly purchased LaCie hard disk drive. You may also download the driver from the LaCie website: http://www.lacie.com/support/drivers/driver.htm?id=10139
- 2. Click twice on the USB Boost Setup.exe and follow the prompts.
- 3. Please note the window welcoming you to the LaCie USB Boostsetup wizard. You must accept the conditions of the driver installation before moving to the next step. Click Install. (Fig. 01)
- 4. A few moments later the setup wizard will finish, prompting you to select Done. (Fig. 02)
- 5. As a final step, the installer sets the parameters of your hardware. (Fig. 03)



3. Selecting the Boost

Once LaCie USB Boost has been installed, you may choose how it will run.

- 1. Note the USB Boost icon within the Taskbar. (Fig. 04)
- 2. Right-click the USB Boost icon to see the options. The default setting is Normal, which means that the driver will not act to increase the speed of select LaCie hard drives. (Fig. 05)
- Select Turbo to take advantage of the USB 2.0 speed enhancements offered by LaCie USB Boost.

IMPORTANT NOTE: LaCie recommends that you select Normal when operating drives that are not supported by LaCie USB Boost.
